I am writing this letter in hopes to address multiple subjects. I will try to make this as brief and concise as possible. However, first, I would like to let you know how appreciative I am of your services. I was extremely impressed with how much that you went out of your way to ensure that I was taken care of. Now, after these long years for an unlawful and illegal conviction, I am hoping to be able to help you in the same way that you helped me.

After a period of time in prison, I slowly began to uncover a web of inconsistencies related to my case. Ultimately, I have ended up with one reversal from the District Court of Appeal, was present at an evidentiary hearing, and am awaiting the final reversal from the District Court of Appeal. This will easily lay out how Ty Roland committed fraud by falsely, fraudulently, knowingly, and willingly submitting a wrongful death insurance policy claim on behalf of the King Family, when there was no evidence that showed I killed Adam King.

You will also find attached the documents that prove what Ty Roland did, how he did it, and why he knew that he was purposefully defrauding your insurance company (Safeco) and abusing his position as an attorney to file false information regarding the claim.

Hopefully, when you receive this information, you will let me know the recourse that you plan to take. I only wish to right a wrong and demonstrate my innocence regarding the supposed "hit and run" accident, and expose such conduct that is unbecoming of trusted attorneys. I believe that you will find the enclosed documents-intriguing, insightful, and helpful in the recovery of your \$250,000. Thank you so much for your help when I needed you most.
